Actual status

- According to Roma Educational and Documentary Centre survey of 2011:
 - 71 per cent of pupils repeating classes are from socially disadvantaged environment.
 - Many pupils repeating classes do not finish primary school (as they reach age of 16 before getting to the 9th class).



Own survey

- Research question:
 - Is there any relationship between participating in microsaving program and educational outputs?
- Subjective perception
- Objective outputs
- Qualitative survey

Subjective perception

- Three towns/villages: Moldava n. Bodvou, Ostrovany, Stará Ľubovňa
 - According to the findings parents claim that participation in IDA program (associated with participation in other ETP programs) influenced their perception of importance of their children's education.
 - Approx ¾ of participants.

Objective outputs


- Idea: Comparison of pupils' learning results (marks)
- **Treatment group:** pupils from families involved in ETP programs
- **Control group:** pupils from other families in the village
- Problems: confidential data

The sample

- 26 pupils, of which
 - 7 pupils from participating families
 - 19 pupils from non-participating families
- Due to small sample size we use bootstrapping.


The distributions (5th grade)

• mean: 1.750714 st. dev: 0.1321828


Histogram of r.mean.nie6




mean: 1.819012 st. dev.: 0.07879406

The distributions (3rd grade)


Histogram of r.mean.ano4

Limitations of the survey

- The most important limitations of the survey:
 - Small sample size
 - Pupils from one school only



Qualitative survey

- **Reviewed:** director of the primary school.
- Conclusions:
 - Most of the pupils are disabled.
 - Change in their health status might influence their results.
 - ETP programs and community centre have positive impacts on the pupils.



Further steps

- Preparation of new survey.
- Inclusion of municipal governments into the survey.
