# Czech Roma – Ethnic or Civic definition?


---

> 0,115%



# Spatial forms of living in RSEL

---

1. Apartment / inhabitants on debt, public owner
2. Apartment / high rent, private owner
3. Block of flats / public owner, bad conditions, most inhabitants on debt, informal arrangements supporting ghettoization

# Spatial forms of living in RSEL

---

1. Family house in the countryside / owned by inhabitants, bad conditions, overpopulation, debts on energies, no possibility of public development projects
2. Rooming house / high rent, private owner, semi-prison conditions

# Spatial forms of living in RSEL

---

1. Street of public houses / usually combination of public and private owners
2. City quarter / combination of owners, underdevelopment of public service, „bad address“ status

# Spatial forms of living in RSEL

---

1. New anti-vandal social housing / „revenge“ for high debts, public owner, high energy bills, no public service
