Special focus of Vítkovice Public Library: Roma people, or socially weak?

- Free time activities for children from socially weaker backgrounds
 - Co-operation with social workes and community centres
 - Unforced socialization of socially weaker parents
 - Upbringing of the new generation of readers
- Library as a community centre –
